December was spent in preparation for the evangelistic outreach we hold each year on the 23rd (a national holiday). While we are making friends, cultivating current friendships and experiences all throughout the year, we do it not only the purpose of witnessing at that time, but also in hopes that when the time comes they will accept an invitation to attend this event where the Gospel is presented through various themes of Christmas. Ken has been going through The "something" of Christmas—this year being the Search for Christmas—dwelling on the shepherds (the message given them and their faith shown in looking for the infant Christ) and the wise men (their faith shown in the journey taken and the gifts given when they found the Christ child) and who can and should search for Christ today. We did this through visual placards, songs, and a testimonial dvd called "The Search" from a Japanese Baptist pastor in southern Japan who was going to follow his father's footsteps and become a special Buddhist priest. We had around 40 here with us (including us, Mrs. Sonoda and Miss Tsuzuki). This included the mayor of Teshio, two mothers of English class students and their children, one family (who attended church 3 weeks ago for the first time), two adult ladies who began the Horonobe English class and Bible study) and the rest were grade school children, one junior high and one high school age student. So whether, we know immediately of what they might be thinking or never know this side of heaven, we will keep working at getting the Gospel into their minds and hearts through this event as well as other services and events throughout the year. We especially pray for **Miss Tsuzuki** to accept the knowledge of the Word that she has understood and proclaimed to be true. Also for **Mayor Asada** (aw-saw-daw) who has heard several of these messages when he attended Christmas programs for the last four years. We continue to try and get together with a couple various ones and families since we have come to know them, seeking to further develop both friendship and the opportunity for deeper spiritual conversations. Thank you for praying for us to this end.

Mrs. Sonoda continues to try and faithfully come on Sunday morning even when she doesn't feel all that well any more on any given day. She has added high blood pressure to her challenges and they have not found the reason for it yet. Nor have they decided to put her on medication as they want to monitor the situation a while longer. Her mother is also back in the hospital and will be given a heart pace maker on the 7th of January. We are thankful that she led her mother to the Lord in salvation quite a few years ago now but her father (and her husband) still needs to be saved. Thank you for joining with us in prayers for them all.

With winter vacation in full force now and the Japanese families doing their get-togethers and special activities over the new years' time, we will not have as much contact with various ones, but we look forward to seeing what God will do in the new year and all throughout 2015! Maybe it will also be the year of Christ's return! Our hearts are always torn betwixt two—"even so come Lord Jesus" and yet, there are so many we desire to reach with the Gospel.

Winter has arrived in all its glory! Television news the other day said that Hokkaido has at least half of the snow fall for a whole winter already on the ground! We had to postpone and/or cancel our English classes twice in the last two weeks. We praise God that on the day of the Christmas program it was all calm.
